Hooger suggested that we just concentrate with the basics then think about about the trailer, trailer generator, etc. He said that we can use the dipoles to start with and if we have the manpower to use the other items to do so. It takes an hour of so just to put the tri-band antenna together and get it on the tower trailer. Matt will bring his generator so we *can* do without the 911 generator.

Charles spoke about ARES briefly. He is looking for simplex frequencies that can be used in addition to the 146.53 frequency that we officially use by the ERARC. Discussion. Hooger suggested contacting the Southeaster Repeater Association <u>http://www.sera.org</u> for options.

Keith said that the '49 is back to its old tricks of working, not working, partially working. Mike said that they've not been back to the site since the last time when feed line issues were corrected. He is purchasing a new site on East River Mountain and will place the new 145.49 antenna, new feed lines, etc. in the near

future. Hopefully this will cut down on all of the problems that we've experienced.
